Prayer Update August to October:

Thank you for your prayers and gifts that are enabling Jigsaw to minister and share God's life-giving love bringing Love, Hope and Life to many.

Thank you for your prayers for the Area 4 squatter area where new covid19 cases were found a number of weeks ago. Despite it being a tightly packed slum area there was not even one new case that arose and the families who had virus cases have all fully recovered. It is truly amazing and miraculous, thank you God.

Thank you for the prayers that have opened the way for Jigsaw to work despite the lockdown. Through your prayers Jigsaw has been given work permits for each Jigsaw worker which has enabled Jigsaw to restart almost all 'The Jigsaw at home' activities over the last few weeks, which is such good news.

Thank you for your prayers for funds needed for Jigsaw. God continues to provide mightily through each of you and his church, thank you. Thank you too for your prayers for funds to come from the Philippines and Asia and we praise God for two significant gifts from Malaysia and the Philippines. Praise God.

Thank you for your prayers for the Jigsaw school sponsorship programme, for the funds to buy 10 Samsung tablets for online schooling support and for God's guidance to begin many new important educational support initiatives (see video update)

Thank you for your life-giving prayers for Ramli Bongolto, a young man who was imprisoned in July for not wearing a face mask. Praise God for prayers answered, we hadn't heard from His family and were worried but this week we heard that Ramli miraculously had been released just days after his arrest (which is unheard of) for no apparent reason, (prayers 😊) thank you God.

Thank you for your prayers for Asia CMS and especially the prison ministry, we praise God that the team were able to go in again this month despite lockdown here, please pray for the wonderful good news of Jesus to rescue lives and set prisoners free.

Lee family update: In lockdown again:) Hi everyone, thank you so much for all your prayers, love and support. Since we last wrote we have gone back into lockdown again which we have just heard is being extended for another four weeks. It is a difficult time, but we are blessed with a large shared outdoor space and good grocery shops nearby. God has been working in all of our lives over the last months and we thank God that things have been becoming much better. James has completed half of his A level and now has started the second year of his study while applying to university for September 2021. Rebekah continues at Norwich Uni although she is now studying remotely from Germany. Despite there being a lockdown, she is still busy organising online Sunday school materials for the church she goes to in Norwich as well as designing materials for online Christian Union events. Grace is busy with her GCSE studies although is finding the online learning quite challenging. She is doing well so far and is looking forward to Christmas whatever that may be like. Kate is back teaching online again from home which is less stressful than last time as all the systems were set up from the last lock down. The very sad news is that Tim's family have had a really sudden unexpected bereavement two weeks ago which has rocked the family. We will keep private for now but please pray for Tim and his two sisters for peace and comfort during these difficult times. Please pray too for Tim who has is so overloaded with the pressures of Jigsaw, work and family and has been advised to take some time off to rest and recoup.

One of the hardest things has been not being able to return to the UK to see family and that Rebekah has not been able to come here. This will be our first Christmas where we are not together as a family and we are all really sad about this. So, we ask for your prayers for a safe and joyous Christmas despite not being able to be together as a family. Thank you for all your kindness, love and prayers Kate and family.
